## EXECUTIVE ORDER

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exists at Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College, Tift

County, Tifton, Georgia, a building known as Beef Unit #2 (Building

#640) (the "Building"); and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents' Policy 9.9.3.3 DEMOLITION authorizes the

Chancellor of Vice Chancellor for Facilities to declare buildings, structures and other improvements no longer advantageously useful to the University System of Georgia. Said building is included within this

policy; and

WHEREAS: It is the opinion of Ms. Linda M. Daniels, Vice Chancellor for Facilities of

the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, that the Building can no longer be advantageously used by Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College or the University System of Georgia and should be

demolished and removed.

Now, therefore, by the power vested in me as Governor of

THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

**ORDERED:** That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby

authorized to demolish and remove the Building from Abraham Baldwin

Agricultural College, Tift County, Tifton, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

**Ordered:** That the appropriate staff of Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College, Tift

County, Tifton, Georgia acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Building and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said demolition and removal to be performed

as expeditiously as possible.
