
That the sum of \$2,579,576.00 be transferred from the Governor's Emergency Fund and credited to appropriation accounts, per detail attached.

Georgia Emergency Management Agency – To provide funds of \$2,579,576 to cover costs associated with the following declared disasters:

On April 27, 2011, severe storms began to affect the State of Georgia, causing tornadoes, hail and damaging winds, resulting in extensive damage in the following 27 counties: Bartow, Butts, Catoosa, Cherokee, Coweta, Dade, Floyd, Gordon, Green, Habersham, Haralson, Harris, Heard, Lamar, Lumpkin, Meriwether, Monroe, Morgan, Newton, Pickens, Polk, Rabun, Spalding, Troup, Upson, Walker, and White.

The anticipated remaining State match for disaster recovery for the declared counties is \$5,905,937. FEMA will contribute approximately \$57,600,314. Local government match contributions will be approximately \$10,849,694.

The additional State Emergency match will be requested in the supplemental budget for FY2012.
