EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exist at Middle Georgia State College – Cochran Campus, Bleckley County, Cochran, Georgia, five improvements known as Whipple Hall (134 Lakeside Drive), Haynes Hall (169 College Street), Chambers House (209 Third Street), Pope Hall (205 South Third Street), and Frank Cook Road Property (162 Frank Cook Road), (the “Buildings”); and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents’ Policy 9.9.3.3 DEMOLITION authorizes the Chancellor or Vice Chancellor for Facilities to declare buildings, structures and other improvements no longer advantageously useful to the University System of Georgia. Said buildings are included within this policy; and

WHEREAS: It has been determined by Mr. Jim James, Vice Chancellor for Facilities of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, that these buildings can no longer be advantageously used by Middle Georgia State College or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove these buildings from Middle Georgia State College, Bleckley County, Cochran, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the appropriate staff of Middle Georgia State College, Bleckley County, Cochran, Georgia, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish these buildings and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
