EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS:

On January 23, 2015, James and Myra Reeves were found in their home in Eastern Floyd County having been the victims

of an apparent double homicide; and

WHEREAS:

The Floyd County Police Department, with the assistance of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, conducted an investigation and were unable to generate any solid leads; and

WHEREAS:

Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of a person who has committed a felony.

Now, therefore, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Georgia, it is hereby

ORDERED:

That a reward in the amount of \$2,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, arrest and conviction of the individual(s) responsible for the murders of James and Myra Reeves.
